<b>Soave Classico</b> "Santa Sofia" - Veneto, Italy The palate is subtle and delicate, with a delightful acidic freshness, moderate alcohol and strong minerality.	£7,50   £27,00
<b>Pecorino Illuminati</b> Abruzzo, Italy On the nose is fine, fragrant, rich in ripe fruit and white flowers tones, almond, field herbs, citrus fruits, slightly spicy.	£8,50   £32,00
<b>Vernaccia di San Gimignano</b> "Le Grillaie" - Tuscany, Italy The aromas are delicate and fresh with notes that recall spring blossoms, green fruit such as apple and pear as well as notes as citrus fruit.	£32,00
<b>Gavi di Gavi DOCG</b> "Batasiolo" - Piemonte, Italy Very elegant with wonderful minerality, citrus bouquet, aka the Italian Chablis.	£10,50   £42,00
<b>Greco di Tufo</b> "Cavalier Pepe" - Campania, Italy Complex aromas of ripe fruits like peach, pear and apple, citrus notes, rich and juicy on the palate with a long and persistent finish.	£44,00
<b>Fiano di Avellino</b> "Re Fiano" - Campania DOCG, Italy A straw yellow coloured white wine with greenish reflections. On the nose it is delicate, with mineral notes and rocky hints.	£44,00
<b>Falanghina Irpinia</b> "Lila" - Campania, Italy Falanghina is a very popular wine for its freshness and generosity in perfumes. Straw yellow in colour with fruity bouquet and persistent notes of citrus.	£44,50
<b>Vermentino Gallura Superiore</b> "Mancini" - Sardegna, Italy Straw yellow with greenish glints. Elegant and refined with an intense and typically aromatic bouquet, notes of grass, wildflowers and tomato leaf.	£45,00
<b>Chardonnay Langhe Vigneto</b> "Morino" - Piemonte, Italy The single vineyard, it rests on yeast in French oak barrels for a period of around eight months.	£11,50   £45,50
<b>Pinot Grigio Collio</b> "Pighin" - Friuli, Italy Floral, fruity, with a delicate aroma of acacia, banana and pineapple. Dry on the palate, excellent body balanced with an elegant aromatic varietal length.	£12,00   £46,00
<b>Sauvignon Blanc Collio</b> "Pighin" - Friuli, Italy Straw yellow with greenish hues, it has vegetal notes of tomato leaf and sage, acacia and elderflower, and fruity notes of white peach and lime, lightly spicy.	£12,00   £46,00
<b>Verdicchio Classico Castelli di Jesi</b> "Podium" - Marche, Italy Intense aroma of ripe yellow fruit accompanied by elegant scents of citrus fruit combined with a note of honey, an ensemble of great complexity and persistency.	£58,00
<b>Etna Bianco</b> "Petalava" Antichi Vinai - Sicily, Italy Etna DOC comes from the Carricante and Catarratto vines, on the slopes of Etna. Floral with pleasant hints of broom flowers, the flavour is harmonious and pleasant.	£60,00
<b>Chardonnay Blanc</b> "Tenuta Mazzolino" - Lombardy, Italy Fermented in "pièce" borgognotte / barrique, refined for 10 months with "batonnage". Morning sun, chalk, salted butter and lemon peel.	£71,00
<b>Sauvignon Blanc RISERVA</b> "Greel" - Alto Adige, Italy The steep slopes on the Renon above Bolzano offer ideal conditions for producing a Sauvignon with unique fruit, minerality, elegance and depth intensive fruit aromas, gooseberry, elderflower, with herbal and delicate wooden notes. <b>Montepulciano d'Abruzzo</b> "Riparosso" Illuminati - Abruzzo, Italy Ruby red with a hint of purple in its early stages, on the nose red fruit notes, on the palate it reveals itself as full-bodied, harmonic and persistent with a final hint of licorice.	£6,50   £24,00
<b>Nero d'Avola</b> "Sciare di Est" - Sicily, Italy Intense, persistent and fine on the palate with balanced tannins, acidity and structure.	£7,50   £28,00
<b>Valpolicella Classico</b> "Santa Sofia" - Veneto, Italy A clean ruby hue with brilliant undertones, an intense aroma of red flowers, cherry, raspberry, red currant, and base notes of spicy cinnamon and coffee.	£32,00
<b>Negroamaro</b> "Rivera" - Puglia, Italy Deep ruby red; emphatic bouquet of wild dark berry fruit, with notes of black liquorice; fruit-rich palate with excellent structure.	£32,00
<b>Chianti Classico</b> "Granaio" - Tuscany DOCG, Italy Bright ruby red with a nose of sweet spice and fragrant red fruit, followed on the palate by juicy sour cherries, summer berries and a long finish with velvety soft tannins.	£10,00   £38,00
<b>Barbera d'Alba Sovrana</b> "Beni di Batasiolo" - Piemonte, Italy The colour is ruby red with delicate purple hues. Intense and persistent olfactory expression with clear references to the red fruits, cherries in brandy and ripe fruit.	£44,00
<b>Primitivo Manduria</b> "Triusco" - Rivera, Puglia, Italy Impenetrable purple colour and intense bouquet of dark berry jam and cocoa, the taste is full and smooth, with fragrant notes of dried plum, cassis, and dark chocolate.	£45,50
<b>Aglianico Riserva DOC</b> Rivera, Puglia, Italy Dense garnet-red; multi-layered bouquet of ripe wild red berry fruit, leather, pipe tobacco and spice; rich palate, austere, very lengthy and well-balanced.	£12,00   £47,00
<b>Ripasso Valpolicella Superiore</b> "Santa Sofia" - Veneto, Italy A clear, remarkably brilliant ruby red colour, it offers a powerful nose, redolent of sour cherries in spirit, prunes, cloves, fine oak, cinnamon and roots of liquorice.	£14,00   £56,00
<b>Vino Nobile Montepulciano</b> "Contucci" - Tuscany, Italy An intense ruby red in colour, fruity aromas with notes of violets and vanilla. The palate is ripe, supple, balanced and with tannins supported by a pleasurable vein of acidity.	£63,00
<b>Pinot Noir</b> "Tenuta Mazzolino" - Lombardia, Italy Broad and profound bouquet highlighting the best Pinot Noir varietal character: an intricate mix of raspberry, pomegranate, tree bark, earth and white pepper.	£16,00   £63,00
<b>Etna Rosso</b> "Antichi Vinai" - Sicily, Italy Petalava Etna DOC Red is an assertive wine with fine tannins and spice on the palate. The nose is intense with floral and red-fruit notes. The ruby colour is impressive.	£65,50
<b>Barbaresco DOCG</b> "Beni di Batasiolo" - Piemonte, Italy Clear garnet red color with delicate orange highlights. It is ethereal, pleasant, intense and persistent, delicately spicy with hints of florals and cooked fruit.	£70,00
<b>Taurasi "Opera Mia"</b> "Tenuta Cav. Pepe", Campania - Italy Dense ruby red with garnet reflections. Aromas of red fruits nad ripe berry fruit complemented by a spicy note of coffee and chocolate and a balsamic finish.	£73,00
<b>Barolo Riserva 2013</b> "Beni di Batasiolo" DOCG - Piemonte, Italy The Nebbiolo grapes are harvested by hand and aged in Slavonian oak casks for a long period of time, Full-bodied and smoothwith a harmonious union of tannins and crisp acidity.	£20,00   £76,00
<b>Amarone della Valpolicella Classico</b> "Santa Sofia" - Veneto, Italy A dark, almost inky ruby red colour with rich garnet hues. Bold yet delicate on the nose, it is redolent of ripe cherries, cassis and prunes.	£84,00
<b>Tignanello 2011</b> "Cantina Antinori" - Tuscany, Italy Tignanello is produced exclusively from the vineyard of the same name, with limestone-rich soils and a southwestern exposure at 350-400 meters above sea level. It was the first Sangiovese wine to be aged in small oak barrels and among the first red wines from the Chianti Classico area to be produced without white grapes.	£540,00
<b>Sassicaia 2005</b> "Tenuta San Guido" - Bolgheri, Tuscany, Italy The vineyards area has a strong presence of limestone and rich in clay and rocks. It is located at an altitude between 80 and 300 meters above sea level. The accumulation of rain during the winter led to a regular germination and the seasonal progression from spring to summer was cool and breezy and the grapes did not suffer in terms of fruit set. The wine was aged for 24 months in oak barriques, after which it ages a further six months in the bottle.	£1200,00
